Mr. Vinton had a list of Richardson marriages in Dracut equally as long. As I read the 944 pages of his book published in 1886, I will be copying all information pertinent to Pelham and add to this offering. Mr. Vinton did a magnificent job of recording the Richardson families and his labor is to be appreciated by all who read it. I could not find Pelham's outstanding early settler, William Richardson, in the four generation Richardson families published in The Vinton Memorial book, but I have found him now.

The Richardson Brothers

Thomas Richardson b. 1543 in Westmill England m. 15 Jun1567 Margaret Silverside. Their son Thomas b. 1570 Westmill 7 Jan 1633-4 m. 25 Aug 1590 Katherine Duxford b. 1565 Westmill, daughter of Richard. Their children are:

Ezekiel Richardson arrived in America with Winthrop's Fleet in 1630. Ezekiel and his wife Susanna (thought to be Bradford) were admitted to the Boston Church as members on 14 Oct 1632, and were dismissed to participate in the organization of the Charlestown church on 2 Nov 1632. Ezekiel's brothers Samuel and Thomas arrived in New England by 1635 with Francis Wyman and John Wyman, sons of their sister Elizabeth Richardson Wyman. The three Richardson brothers were commissioned by Governor John Winthrop to establish the colony now known as Woburn MA, and were know as Pillars of the church that they helped to build and organize. The Richardson brothers and their descendants are known to be "movers and shakers" in the development throughout New England, and later throughout the United States. We will concentrate herein on their families in Pelham NH, beginning with descendants of Ezekiel and Susanna. Children:

Capt. William Richardson b. 19 Sept 1701 (Josiah 3-2 Ezekiel) m. 1722 Elizabeth Colburn of Dracut (Daniel & Sarah). They settled in Dracut (Pelham) and William's Will was proved 7 Nov 1776. Their children:

Daniel b. 10 Jan 1783 m. 1st Mary Adams, 2nd Hannah Adams.

Elizabeth Richardson b. 10 Oct 1696 Chelmsford (Jonathan 3 Josiah 2 Ezekiel) m. Edward Colburn of Dracut. Their children:

Mary Richardson b. 26 une 1699 (Jonathan 3 Josiah 2) m. 1717 Dr. Samuel Colburn of Dracut. Children: Mary, Samuel, Jonahan, Elizabeth, Martha, Hexekiah.

Capt. Zachariah Richardson b. Feb 1695-6 Chelmsford d. 22 Mar 1776 (Josiah 3-2-Ezekiel) m. Sarah Butterfield b. 23 Sept 1701 d. 11 May 1798 (Benjamin & Sarah). Children: Sarah b. 13 Oct 1719. Zachariah b. 23 Apr 1726 m. Timothy Fletcher. Deborah b. 1 June 1727 m. Joseph Farrar. Lydia b. 17 May 1728 m. Jacob Chamberlain. Mercy or Mary b. 20 Feb 1730. Josiah b. 8 May 1734 m. Lydia Warren. Rebecca b. 10 Feb 1735-6. Lucy b. 11 Nov 1742 m. Peter Spalding 26 May 1763. Phebe m. 28 Dec 1800 Joseph Butterfield Varnum of Dracut.

Note: Reading the Richardson Memorial has also helped me to connect one of my DAR sisters to my Baldwin's of Woburn. This book written by John Vinton is an amazing work, and I am not surprised that it took years of research to complete.

Ezekiel Richardson b. about 1690 (Thomas 3 James 2 Ezekiel) m. Mary? Children: Ezekiel b. 24 Sept 1714 m. Elizabeth Watson. Mary b.& d. Feb 1717 Dracut. Edward b. 19 Jan 1718 m. Sarah Blood. Mary b. 24 Jun 1720. Ezekiel Jr. sold the farm in Dracut and is believed to have purchased land in Pelham where he died in 1820, leaving his widow Mary with several children that included Amien and Dorothy, who were placed under the guardianship of his son Ezekiel in 1820. Dorothy m.1821-2 James B. Currier of Pelham.

James Richardson b. 3 May 1713 Dracut (James 3 Thomas 2 Ezekiel) m. 1741 Mary Richardson. They were in the section of Dracut that became Pelham. Children: James b. 17 Jun 1742 m. Sarah Clark. Abijah b. 13 Feb 1748 m. Judith Clark. Molly (no date) m. Asa Stickney 11 Feb 1768. Olive b. 7 Jul 1754 m. Cyrus Hardy. Bridget b. 28 Jun 1758 m. Jacob Marsh 12 Dec 1785. Ezekiel b. 7 Mar 1761 m. 1st Betsey Coburn, 2nd Dolly Littlehail.

Phillip b. 1 Oct 1715 m. 1st 1744 Eleanor Wood of Pelham, 2nd Hannah? Phillip's child w/ Eleanor: Phillip m. Mehitabel Hill. Children with Hannah: Hannah b. 8 Oct 1758. Eliphalet b. 7 Sept 1760 m. 1st Lavinia Butler, 2nd Elizabeth. James b. 5 Mar 1763 m. Polly Taylor. Molly b. 24 Mar 1765. Betsey b. 4 Mar 1767. Zachariah b. 14 Apr 1771 m. 13 May 1800 Polly Parker, living in Dunstable MA.

Sarah Richardson b. 5 Aug 1796 (John 3, Josiah 2, Ezekiel 1) m. 1715 John Colburn of Dracut. I include this because I think it is pertinent to Pelham.

Eleazer Richardson b. about 1720 Chelmsford (Samuel 3 Joseph 2 Ezekiel) m. Lydia Perham of Chelmsford.

Hon. William Merchant Richardson b. 4 Jan 1774 (Daniel 5 Wm 4 Josiah 3-2 Ezekiel) m. 7 Oct 1799 Betsey Smith b. 5 Nov 1773 (Jesse) Both born in Pelham. He was a Harvard graduate and received his law degree from Dartnouth in 1827; principal of the

Groton MA Academy, postmaster of Groton 1804-12, twice elected from the Middlesex District to the U.S. House of Representatives. In 1814, Wm. Resigned his seat in Congress and removed to Portsmouth NH where he resumed his law practice. He was appointed Chief Justice of the NH Supreme Court in 1816, a position that he held for 22 years, until his death 16 Mar 1838. A man of many talents, Wm. also was a musician as was his brother General Samuel M. Richardson for whom William fashioned a fiddle. Children: Sarah Merchant b. 3 May 1800 m. Dr. Samuel M. Barker. Gen. Samuel Mather Richardson b, 12 Jan 1776 Pelham (Daniel 5 Wm 4 Josiah 3-2) d. 11 Mar 1858 Pelham, m. 1st 26 Jun 1798 Abigail Spofford, 2nd Hannah Hardy (Daniel). Samuel and his family occupied the family farm of his father, and taught school in Pelham 1796. He representative from Pelham to the General Court of NH for twelve years and was for one year a member of the State Senate. He served as a Major in the War of 1812, and then as Brigadier General in the NH Militia. Samuel had no children. It most certainly should be mentioned that Gen. Richardson donated the land upon which the Pelham Congregational Church stands

Honorable Daniel Richardson b. 19 Jan 1783 Pelham d. 12 Feb 1842, (Daniel Wm Josiah 3-2) m. 1st 2 Apr 1816 Mary Adams b. 4 Jan 1788 d. 1 Aug 1826 Pelham. M. 2nd Mary's sister Hannah Adams b. 14 Jul 1803. Danel studied law in Groton and settled in Tyngsboro where he condicted a successful law pratice. He was postmaster of Groton for 35 years, selectman in 1817, Representative to the General Court for two years, and held various town offices.

Children by his 1st wife Mary:

James b. 15 May 1773 n. Betsey? Joseph b. 1 Aug 1775 m. 1 Mar 1802 Joanna Gage. John b. 7 Mar 1778, thought to marry Martha Parker.. Solomon b. 24 Dec 1780 m. Hannah Currier. Molly b. 10 Feb 1786.

Abijah Richardson ,brother of James above, b. 13 Feb 1748 d. 13 Jul 1784 m. 16 Oct 1775 Judith Clark. They lived in Pelham. Children:
Nehemiah b. 11 Feb 1777 m. Rebecca Herick. Rhoda b. 3 Oct 1784 m. Daniel Gage.

Ezekiel Richardson, beother of Abijah & James, b. 7 Mar 1761 Dracut m. 1st 22 Feb 1787 Betsey Colburn. 2nd 25 Nov 1790 Dolly Littlehail. They lived in Dracut, their farm

adjoining the boundary line of Tyngsboro. Children: Joseph. **Ezekiel** m. 3 Feb 1820 Sybil Marsh, lived in Pelham with their children: Sybil b. 5 Apr 1822. Jacob b. 26 Nov 1820.

Eliphalet Richardson b. 7 Sept 1760 Pelham d. 21 Aug 1821(Phillip5 James 4 Thomas 3 James 2 Ezekiel) m. 1st Lavinia Butler and appears to have removed to Royalston, Worcester County. Children: Daniel, Betsey and Licinda.

James Richardson b. 5 Mar 1768 Pelham m. 23 June 1800 Polly Taylor. Children: Sybil b. 11 Feb 1802, James b. 16 Apr 1803, Mary b. 12 Jul 1809, and Olive b. 20 Jun 1811. James m. Betsey Johnson.

Thomas Richardson b. 1750 Westford MA (Thomas 5 James 4 Thomas 3 James 2 Ezekiel) m. 1st 28 Nov 1774 Abigail Spaulding, 2nd Lucy Spaulding about 1780. Lived in Pelham. Children: Thomas b. 9 Mar 1771, Abigail b. 13 Jun 1772, Jesse b. 6 Jan 1773. Willard b. 13 Mar 1774, Hannah b. 23 Jan 1776.

Samuel Richardson b. 20 May 1800 Pelham d. 1829, son of Samuel & Tamar Colburn Richardson (Moses 5 Josiah 4-3-2 Ezekiel) m. Sybil Richardson b. 1788 Chelmsford (dgtr of Josiah & Sybil). Samuel was a stonecutter in Pelham who dies intestate and insolvent. Among his creditors were Richardson relatives; Olive, Asa, Mary, his father Sanuel, and cousin Israel of Dracut. A sad ending to a short lifespan.

Louisa Richardson b. 21 May 1807 Dracut (Thaddeus 6 David 5 Josiah 4-3-2 Ezekiel)
m. Jan 1830 John Richardson of Pelham, where John was a shoemaker. Children:
Charles A. b. 20 Apr 1833. Marietta b. 4 Jun 1845. Louisa b. 9 Oct 1846.

James Richardson b. 15 May 1773 d. about 1837 Pelham, son of James & Sarah Clark Richardson (James 5-4 Thomas 3 James 2 Ezekiel) m. Betsey. He was a yeoman and died intestate. Jesse Gibson of Pelham was appointed administrator 2 Oct 1832, setting off the widow dower. Childen: Mary m. Hobbs. Eliphalet appears unmarried and died in Pelham 1837.

Samuel Richardson b. in England m. Joanna Thake of England. Samuel d. 23 Mar 1658 Woburn MA. Children are:

Samuel 2 b. 22 May 1646 m. 1st Martha, 2nd Hannah Kingsley, 3rd Phebe Baldwin (Henry), 4th Sarah Hayward. Samuel's 1st wife d. young, his 2nd wife, infant daughter and son were killed by Indians in their home at Woburn, 3rd wife d. young.

Thomas b. 31 Dec 1651 d. 17 Sept 1657 m. 27 Sept 1657 Rebecca Vinton at Woburn. Elizabeth b. 1665, living 1666 at time of mother's will. Samuel d. 29 Apr 1712.

Joseph Richardson 2 b. 1643 Woburn m. 5 Nov 1666 Hannah Green (Joseph & Hannah Green). Joseph d. 5 Mar 1717-18. Children: Hannah b. 22 Oct 1667 m. Daniel Baldwin (Henry 1). Mary b. 22 Mar 1668-9 m. 1st James Fowle 2nd Samuel Walker, both of Woburn.

Jonas Richardson, son of Ebenezer & Ruth, b. Pelham 21 Oct 1748 m. 4 Apr 1782 Zizpha Barker. Children: Ruth b. 10 Jan 1783. James b. 12 May 1784. Achah b. 7 Jun 1786. The family lived in Pelham until 1786 and moved to VT.

Eri Richardson, son of Dr. Amos Richardson of Pelham (Stephen 3-2-Samuel 1) b. about 1740 m. 26 Sept 1762 Sarah Durant. They lived in Pelham. Children: Amos b. 27 Feb 1764. Reuben b. 30 Mar 1766 d. Oct 1767. Phebe b, 25 Jun 1768. Eldad b. 20 Nov 1769. Lemuel b. 23 aug 1771. Rhoda b. 5 Jul 1774. Benjamin b. 20 Mar 1777. Eri b. 6 Mar 1779. Eri Jr.'s son m. 11 sept 1848 Sophronia Bidwell, both of Lowell MA.

Joseph Richardson, brother of Eri above, b. 5 Mar 1745 Dracut d. 10 Apr 1827
Pelham,m. 11 May 1767 Miriam Hildreth (Joseph & Rebecca Wright Hildreth) of Dracut.
They lived in Pelham. Children: Miriam b. 24 Aug 1768 m. Joshua Wyman of Pelham.
Joseph b. 21 Jan 1771 m. 1st Hibbard 2nd Lydia Wilkins.
Sarah b. 10 Mar 1778 m. John Higgins. David b. 15 Jan 1776 m. Sarah Goodman Ford.
Josiah b. 12 Dec 1778 became a Baptist minister. Mary b. 4 May 1781 m. A. Hibbard.

Henry Baldwin and his cousin John Baldwin of Pelham are great grandsons of both Ezekiel Richardson and his brother Samuel. Thomas Richardson is their great uncle whose daughter Mary m. their great uncle John Baldwin of Billerica. Elizabeth Richardson of England is their ancestral aunt and her husband Francis Wyman is their ancestral uncle.
